

# Two seek Crossroads Zone national director position

Two candidates are seeking the Crossroads Zone national director position — current “temporary” Crossroads Zone Director Bob Henning of Mishawaka, Ind. and Clifford Tattersall of Welland, Ont.

The official ballot is below and also will appear in the February issue of *Turning Wheels*. Unlike previous years, all votes must be cast on the official ballot or exact copies of the official ballot. Petitions for a particular candidate signed by supporters will not be accepted.

Up for election is an unfinished term of the Crossroads Zone national director, ending April 15, 2013. The reason for the special election was the resignation of former Crossroads Zone Director Tom Curtis after he was elected president of the Studebaker Drivers Club.

Under SDC Bylaws, vacant national director positions automatically are offered to zone coordinators, but Crossroads Zone Coordinator Sharon Krueger declined appointment. So the SDC president appointed a temporary national director who now must run in a special election

**Bob Henning** was appointed temporary Crossroads Zone national director in October. He also serves as SDC’s Indiana regional manager and is chairman of SDC’s Capital Cost Committee that funds Studebaker National Museum projects.

Henning also is the co-chair of the 2012 SDC International and has co-chaired of the Michiana Chapter’s an-

nual Studebaker Indiana swap meet and car show held each year in May in South Bend.

Henning has served on the board of directors for the St. Joseph County March of Dimes and worked on promotional projects with many South Bend area not-for-profit organizations. He is vice president of a broadcasting company.

Henning said he will use his media experience to boost SDC’s social media presence, including Facebook..

“It has been said by some that there is a need for new blood. I am new blood,” he said. “Together we will take the Studebaker Drivers Club to a new level, a level that we can all be proud of.”

**Clifford Tattersall** has been a member of the Hamilton Chapter /Studebaker Drivers Club since 2008 and has been a fan of Studebakers from boyhood. His father owned two. He presently owns two Studebakers, a 1955 Studebaker President Deluxe and a 1966 Cruiser. Both cars are drivers, one or the other has attended various meets including Cedar Rapids, Iowa; South Bend, Ind.; Chillicothe Ohio; and Springfield Mo.

He is retired from a career with Transport Canada/Canadian Coast Guard and lives in the Welland, Ont. He is a member of the Hamilton Chapter.

“I would appreciate your vote. I will represent the Crossroads Zone with honesty and integrity on the National Board,” he said.
